You may also choose to join the group being taught by Shannon Neal. This will be a class just for the Transformed Living Study. They will meet in the Hospitality room during the Sunday school hour.

Central Methodist has always had a fine organ and enjoyed an excellent music program. We are lucky now to have the fine Casavant organ give by the Shirley family in 1984 and an excellent musician, Jim O'dell, to lead the music program.

Mrs. Zeb Jones (Naomi) was organist from 1937 till 1961. Many of us remember her fondly. We also remember how cold and hot the choir loft could be in the old church. For a number of years the wasps were pretty bad and many were crushed as hymn books were clammed shut. Most of the pastors got used to them but it was unnerving for the choir to see a wasp on the bald head of the preacher. Those who have ever been in the choir know that you see a lot of things that the congregation never realizes.

In the old church there were a number of pianos and the children always began Sunday School classes with the singing of two or three hymns. Some of us grew tired of This Is My Father's World and Fairest Lord Jesus. Were these the only songs the piano player knew?
